T. J. BODGIT rated a short lead inside, widened through the final turn, came under pressure from the head of the lane and kept alert to prove much the best. HOLY BOOM kept just off the pace and off the rail, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole and settled for second best while no match for the winner. GINGER KID, brushed early, rated off the pace about the three path, saved ground with a bid from the quarter pole then leveled off down the lane. SWEETIE, jostled early, settled well back inside, started a bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, eased to the three path rounding the final turn and finished evenly near the rail. TILT TIL DAWN saved ground off the pace and made a mild bid from the quarter pole. BARAK'S SWEET PEA, off the pace inside, showed little response on the backstretch. JUST STRUTTIN' rated close to the early pace off the rail, picked up the chase from the seven sixteenths pole then faded rounding the final turn. BREEZY ARCH was brushed early and not a factor while saving ground. SLIMMING IN BLACK, pinched early, settled back outside. COME TO DADDY was no factor saving ground.
