Footnotes

FINE rated well back of the early pace inside, started a bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, took over just inside the quarter, raced clear mid turn and held well under steady stretch handling. TEN MISSIONS, well back toward mid track, bid at the three eighths pole, improved four wide on the final turn and finished well, while not good enough. BABY TIME settled well back toward mid track, started a bid saving ground nearing the three eighths pole, closed to a boxed in situation approaching the top of the stretch but dug in from the eighth pole to duel for third a sixteenth away. CAMP TOPRIDGE stalked the pace off the rail, was driven from the quarter pole, eased three wide into the lane but leveled off while drifting outward. MAY KING took over two deep nearing the thirteen sixteenths pole, rated the pace inside from that point, was pressured nearing the final turn, caught past the quarter pole then faded down the lane. REAL QUIET TIME, well off the pace toward the outside, saved ground on the turns. BUCKEY ROAD bobbled a stride from the gate, kept just off the early pace about the three path, started a chase three wide past the seven sixteenths pole and held aim to the middle of the final turn before giving way. CONFEDERATE SILVER was never a factor. BEAT THE SPREAD stalked the early pace four wide, dropped back from the five eighths pole and showed no response on the backstretch. ECLIPTICAL'S ELVIS, off the pace about the four path, faded after a half mile.
