Footnotes

WAVES AND TIDES stalked the pace from the rail, waited for room from the three-sixteenths pole to upper stretch, got through nearing the eighth pole and quickly drew clear under a drive. BOPING ALONG set the pace along the rail, turned back a bid from BOPSICLE nearing the lane, drifted out a bit turning for home, could not keep pace with the winner in upper stretch but finished willingly to preserve the place. QUICK SHOW settled off the pace along the rail, went four wide around the far turn and rallied mildly to gain the show. KING OF BOP tracked the pace three wide, bid three wide between rivals nearing the lane and flattened out in the stretch. VIRGINIA AFFAIR steadied entering the first turn, saved ground around that bend, advanced in the two path around the far turn, angled three wide turning for home and drifted in under right-handed urging in the lane. CAPTAIN TEN lacked speed while two and three wide and passed tiring rivals. HIGHNTHESKYMERCUY never factored while racing three and four wide. BOPSICLE was hustled up toward the lead, chased the pace from the rail around the first turn, bid two wide near the three-eighths pole, pressed the pace two deep past the three-sixteenths pole and tired in upper stretch. FOX DRIVE raced four wide around the first turn and was outrun.
