LOVE LIKE OURS moved to the lead toward the inside, was soon clear to take the rail, rated to the head of the lane, came under pressure at that point and held on well. GETTHELASTWORDIN, bumped early, chased the pace three wide, held aim under a hardy drive through the turn but relented the stretch. HEY U broke inward, chased the pace from the inside and finished evenly. PENSAO showed no speed inside, eased outward on the turn, entered the stretch in the five path and finished evenly. LETMEASKUAQUESTION bore in early, chased the pace from the outside, saved some ground through the turn then leveled off in the lane. CLOSING SCENE, shuffled back at the start, quickly picked up the chase off the rail, was in her best position at the quarter pole but leveled off through the turn. HENNESSY BEAUTY, forced in early, was not a factor. STORMIN DEPUTY was hustled with a brief early lead inside, overcome near the three eighths pole and steadily faded from there. HEAVENS CHEER broke out making contact with Getthelastwordin, appeared rank early and was no factor. SOUNDS FREUDIAN, bumped inward to the heels of Getthelastwordin early, appeared erratic afterward, was eased, dismounted on the turn and walked off.
