WILD JERSEY BOY made the lead down the backstretch, held clear through the turn then was all out to prevail. UNSUNG ENCORE pressed the pace outside the winner, moved to that one in late stretch but could not get by and lasted for second in a game effort. SANDRO PAZZO prompted the issue from the rail, moved to the pace setters in mid stretch and just missed in a strong effort. BULL POINT lunged at the start, forced the pace three wide, lacked a closing bid when asked in the lane. CHIEF EXECUTIONER stalked the leaders while kept four wide, failed to respond in the drive. VINTAGE WOODMAN never threatened, three wide. PLATINUM MISSILE never was a factor on the rail.
