SWEET TOWNSHIP advanced three and four wide then in a long drive, was up in the final strides. RAINYDAYBELLS pressed the issue just off the rail, made a slim lead nearing the sixteenth pole, missed in a strong effort. POLLY PERFECT moved up five wide down the backstretch, dropped to the rail on the turn, finished well. PEGGY LONGLEGS set the pace on the rail, led until near the sixteenth pole before weakening. BOZENA three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. DEFREREST BURN well placed on the rail, lacked a late response. JAMIE'S SILENT BID was no factor on the rail. DOCTOR BRITT forced the pace four wide, tired. TURN TO BLUE went to her knees at the start, saved ground but had no rally.
