ROCKY MARSH stalked the pace two deep while between horses the first turn, took the lead near the seven sixteenths pole, contested the rail through the final turn, drifted slightly making light contact with Mr. Kwok in the upper and mid points of the stretch and held on determinedly. MR. KWOK settled off the early pace about the four path, closed to contention through the backstretch, contested the final turn two deep, was brushed lightly at the eighth pole then again near the sixteenth but remained a game factor to the wire. ROCK OUT chased the pace inside, eased out entering the stretch and finished evenly, a distant third. THERE'S ANDY stalked the pace three wide to the three eighths pole, gave chase from that point then faded through the final turn. LUCA'S WIND DANCER came away a step slow and awkwardly and never factored. VINNY CHASE, off the pace two deep, weakened nearing the final turn. CHESTNUT PRIZE came away a step slow and raced five wide the first turn. GATOR GUY held a slim lead inside the opening turn and gave brief chase into the backstretch before readily giving way. MILLWOOD came away a step slow and never factored.
