FLATTERING ANNIE advanced two wide between foes around the turn, closed outside and was up in deep stretch. KASHAYA set the pace along the rail and led until deep stretch. VIRGINIA PARK forced the pace from the rail and finished evenly to hold the show position. THREE SIXTY lacked speed, raced three wide around the turn and rallied belatedly. STOLEN PENNIES failed to menace while racing three wide. HEY U saved ground to no avail. KNOBIE bumped ISLAND MEMORIES just after the start and was no further factor while racing four wide. CLEARCUTADVANTAGE had brief speed three wide. JENS ANGEL was not a factor while racing two wide. ISLAND MEMORIES was bumped just after the start and never threatened while racing three wide.
