SOSEXc rated a short lead inside, was urged away under a moderate hand ride into the lane but allowed to relax through the final sixteenth. LIE OF THE TIGER, four wide the first turn, settled off the pace three wide, bid leaving the three eighths pole and while no match for the winner, finished well in place. DESERT BABY rated off the pace off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, steadied toward the five sixteenths pole, resumed her drive into the final turn and finished well to duel for show. RACINGMOLLYGREEN rated back toward the outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, rounded the final turn five wide and finished evenly. I FOUND SWEETIEPIE stalked the early pace inside, bid at the rail leaving the three eighths pole then leveled off in the stretch. GOLD MEDAL GAL stalked the pace two deep, gave chase from the three eighths pole and loomed close to the head of the lane before weakening. MOON DROP, well back inside, improved her position from the five sixteenths pole, lacked room at the rail nearing the head of the lane then made a mild bid through the lane. MRS C, off the pace in the three and four paths, steadied near the five sixteenths pole and lacked further. EXECUTIVE ANNA rated close to the early pace inside then faded from the three eighths pole. TAX OPPONENT was sluggish into stride and no factor.
