Footnotes

CENTRIPETAL MOTION settled well back from the early pace inside, bid leaving the seven sixteenths pole, angled four wide on the final turn, took over just inside the furlong pole and was steadily encouraged to widen slightly. OH SO CLEVER angled in to save ground entering the first turn, rated the pace to the quarter pole, came under pressure midway on the final turn, yielded to the winner at the eighth pole but finished evenly to hold onto place. WILDCAT SKIER dropped back from a brief lead inside to stalk the pace, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole and finished evenly at the outside flank of the runner-up. HOLD THAT ECHO, well back inside, saved ground with a bid leaving the three eighths pole, eased to the four path into the lane but leveled off in deep stretch. TREZ kept close to the pace in the four path, gave chase from the three eighths pole, had aim midway on the final turn but lacked further in the stretch. ECLIPTICALS WHISKY was not a factor. FOREVER TANGO chased the early pace about the three path then faded at the rail rounding the final turn.
