IDEAL THOUGHTS sprinted clear early, set the pace along the rail, was under a drive in upper stretch then taken in hand while well clear through the final sixteenth. GOLDEN DEBUTANTE bumped with SHORT HILL KIT KAT just after the start, chased the pace three wide and finished willingly to gain the place. CAT NIP KITTY saved ground and rallied mildly to gain the show. SOUL QUEEN went evenly while racing four wide. SHORT HILL KIT KAT was bumped just after the start, raced five wide around the turn and improved her position in the lane. RAPID VICTORY raced inside and failed to menace. GOLDEN BUTTERFLY was no factor while racing three wide. MISS CITY SLICKER chased the pace two wide, faded leaving the three-sixteenths pole and steadied when in a bit tight in midstretch. LIMIT LASS was pinched back early and never involved while racing two wide.
