Footnotes

JOE'S LAD chased the early pace two deep, angled in passing the five sixteenths pole, eased around the pacesetter in the upper stretch, dug in from there to take control a sixteenth away and drew clear nearing the wire. CRAZY AS CAN BE was hustled clear to save ground, dug in to the winner's challenge at the head of the lane, yielded to that one at the sixteenth pole then just lasted to get the nod in place. EXCESS POWER chased the pace off the rail, rounded the turn in the three path, dug in from the top of the stretch and just missed place by a head bob. PEACE BUSTER chased the pace from the inside, was shut off checking past the five sixteenths pole, quickly resumed pursuit but leveled off in the lane. ENGLISH BREAKFAST chased the early pace outside, saved some ground through the turn then had little left in the stretch. WARRIOR NATION bobbled a stride or two from the gate, lacked speed outside then bid mildly through the stretch. PARKER'S CHARM gave chase from off the rail though proved no factor. SONNY C steadied after breaking a step slow. GOLDY SONG chased the pace toward mid track, saved some ground through the turn, showed no response in the stretch, pulled up short after the wire and was vanned off sore. WAR LION hesitated several lengths at the break. The stewards reviewed a claim of foul against the winning rider, lodged by the rider of Peace Buster, though took no action.
