Footnotes

AUTUMN AFFAIR rated with the pace two deep, came under pressure nearing the five sixteenths pole, contested at a slight disadvantage rounding the final turn but dug in under determined handling to take over and inch ahead inside the sixteenth pole. BLUSHING B. J. awkward at the break, stalked the pace three wide, bid leaving the quarter pole and dug in gamely to duel for place. BELLA THE PRINCESS settled off the pace off the rail, eased toward the outside leaving the nine sixteenths pole, steadily improved through the backstretch, bid in the four path near the quarter pole and finished well to show while outfinished for place. AWOW rated with the pace inside, was pressured from the five sixteenths pole, contested a slim advantage through the final turn and held the edge to just inside the sixteenth pole before grudgingly ceding. PEONY PERFECT saved ground off the early pace, moved toward mid track nearing the final turn and showed little further. EDEN STAR rated close to the early pace off the rail, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole and kept aim through the final turn before weakening. USHANKA, off the early pace about the four path, saved ground on the final turn. DANCING AT NICKIES, shuffled back early, raced well off the pace saving ground.
