AVIATION SHOW settled off the pace along the inside, advanced inside around the far turn, tipped out nearing the eighth pole and rallied for second. ELДАРION pressed the pace four wide around the first turn, pressed two deep around the far turn and weakened in the lane. HALTON GULLY was forced to alter out sharply midway around the first turn, raced four and five wide throughout and finished with good energy. BUBBA BEAR saved ground to no avail. FEISTY ALBERT saved ground early, raced five wide around the far turn and failed to menace. ST. JOHNSWOOD pressed the pace two wide between foes and tired around the far turn. SMART EXECUTIVE had brief speed three wide. DEED IT IS lost his action midway around the first turn, was pulled up and walked off.
