**Footnotes**

MUGSY DEHERE rated a slim lead inside, came under pressure at the five sixteenths pole to maintain the edge through the final turn, drew away toward the head of the lane and held on well under steady handling. SHORT CUT, unhurried well back and inside, closed near the rail through the backstretch, eased out toward the quarter pole, steadily improved four wide on the final turn, dueling for place into the lane and finished strong. SILVER SPELL rated with the early pace two deep, challenged the winner from the five sixteenths pole and dueled close through the final turn before leveling off. SCARY STORM settled off the pace two deep the opening turn, gave chase from the half mile pole, closed in mid track through the backstretch but lacked further while three wide on the final turn. SMART SAINT raced at even terms early, dropped back into the opening turn, stayed in range through the backstretch then saved ground while leveling off on the final turn. MILLENNIUMSUNRISE settled off the pace inside the opening turn, raced at the heels of Smart Saint near the five sixteenths pole then faded rounding the final turn. MARQUEE KISSES, CHE CHE MERENGUE, SHADY SLIM and TIME IS NOW were all not factors.
