INDY KRIZZ stumbled at the start, moved up four wide, made a clear lead on the turn then was all out to prevail. STOPTHEFEVER forced the pace three wide, bid five wide around the turn, finished strongly. JINJALAD within striking distance four wide, lacked a late response. GRANDPA GIBBY five wide, passed tiring rivals. REASON TO DRINK gained a clear lead three wide along the backstretch, faded through the stretch. I. TURNER prompted the issue three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. CANCEL THE SHOW was used up after a half, three wide. WILD MAMBO well placed inside, had no rally. MAX COOPER up close on the rail, lacked the needed rally. FAVRITEMEMRYOFMINE set the pace just off the rail, stopped after a half.
