MALIBU KID pressed the issue while just off the rail, was set down for the drive, gained the lead in deep stretch. GATTOPARDO set the pace on the rail, dug in when challenged, led until deep stretch. COLONEL J W forced the issue four wide, angled to the rail on the turn then finished willingly. PETER'S CREEK broke awkwardly and was bumped, prompted the pace three wide, lacked a late bid. TERMSOFENGAGEMENT off slow then bumped at the start, found his best stride late while four wide. TAP TAP I WIN was no factor, three wide.
