PURE REY (ARG) set the pace near the rail, drew off around the far turn and held well clear under left-handed urging. DUG BAR settled off the pace along the inside, advanced inside around the far turn, continued on his left lead in the lane and finished willingly between foes to gain the place. CLOSING HOUR tracked the pace three wide and was outfinished for the place. CHEROKEE CARL lagged inside and rallied belatedly along the rail. GANGA failed to menace while racing two and three wide. DAKOTA ROADHOUSE went evenly while racing two wide. RARE LUKEY pressed the pace two wide and faltered around the far turn. ANNA'S FIREBALL was never a factor while racing four wide. TEXAS HOLLADAY had brief speed two wide. FIRST AND BAY trailed well off the rail.
