STORED KISSES broke well from between foes to gain the early advantage, widen the margin up the backstretch, remained clear entering the second turn, responded to pressure entering the drive and was clear late under steady urging. LIL DALE chased the early pace from the outside, remained forward entering the second turn but was no match for the winner. BEST TO GO WEST broke out at the start bumping with BOWMAN'S HERO, chased the early pace, remained forward entering the second turn but was no threat to the top two. REFLECTED AFFAIR well placed from between foes, was no threat late. SILVER TIE AFFAIR could only pass tired ones. RUGBYSROLLINGSTONE was no factor. PRINCE AFLEET was no threat. ANTIETAM BAY chased the early pace from the outside, veered out in the stretch and was outrun. FLATTERING PRAISE broke well from the outside to force the early pace, broke down entering the backstretch and was vanned off. BOWMAN'S HERO was bumped at the start and lost rider.
