Footnotes

BATTLE MOUNTAIN settled back back from the early pace toward mid track, bid leaving the three eighths pole, took control in the three path leaving the final turn then widened under a strong drive from the sixteenth pole. GENERAL RUTLEDGE stalked the pace inside, gave chase after the opening five sixteenths, moved to the lead near the seven sixteenths pole, raced clear nearing the final turn, yielded into the lane and settled for second best. DARNLITTLECASH settled off the early pace inside, bid from the five sixteenths pole, eased out through the final turn, entered the stretch in the three path and dueled for show. TYRAE, off the pace inside, came under pressure from the three eighths pole then leveled off in the lane. REAL QUIET TIME, well back off the rail, made a mild bid from the five sixteenths pole but had nothing further in the lane. CHIEF EXECUTIONER rated a slim early lead two deep, moved to the rail after the opening five sixteenths, relinquished control toward the seven sixteenths pole but continued to give chase to the quarter pole before fading. JUSTICE IS SERVED, well back off the rail early, bid mildly after a half mile and finished evenly outside. UNCLE BOB'S VIPER steadied early while saving ground, was roughed on the heels of Battie Mountain the first turn and no factor after. WESTERN FRONTIER saved ground.
