OILTON sluggish at the start, was allowed to settle and steadily moved up three and four wide, made the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and drove clear. LIVELY REPARATIONS gained a slim lead down the backstretch on the rail, dug in around the turn, came up short in a good effort. BAILEYS BEACH up close early, fell back along the backstretch, finished well through the stretch. GREEN SPRING BOY pressed the pace from the inside, remained a factor on the turn, lacked the needed late rally. SEA RESCUE bid just off the rail down the backstretch, had aim around the turn, came up empty in the drive. GANGA forced the issue three and four wide, tired. MYSTICAL NOTION stopped after a half along the inside.
