**Footnotes**

CONGRESIONALAFFAIR stalked the pace two deep, bid leaving the five sixteenths pole, took over at the quarter, dueled clear midway on the final turn and held well under a steady drive. EXECUTIVE ANNA rated close inside, bid nearing the final turn and dueled late for place. SPITHA rated a short lead inside, came under pressure past the five sixteenths pole, gave chase from the quarter then lost ground leaving the turn and leveled off in the stretch. RAINYDAYBELLS, five wide the first turn, was kept off the pace toward mid track and leveled off in the stretch. GOLD MEDAL GAL, unhurried early, made a four wide bid on the final turn but proved empty in the stretch. MARCI'S WAY was outrun while off the rail. LUSCIOUS LADY showed no speed inside. KITTIAHAWK broke awkwardly and never factored. FLYING SPIRIT settled just off the pace about the three path the opening half mile then gave way on the final turn. NICK'S RANSOM came six wide the opening turn and never factored.
