FAMILY CHIEF settled back about the three path, bid off the rail past the quarter pole, angled six wide leaving the final turn, dug in for the lead in late stretch and drew clear toward the wire. JJALAD, pinched back at the rail nearing the nine sixteenths pole, settled back inside, started a bid approaching the three eighths pole, eased out from mid turn, entered the stretch about the five path, lugged inward while his rider attempted to correct course, took a slim brief late lead and while outfinished for the win, won the nod for second. DANGEROUS WARRIOR rated just off the pace inside, rounded the final turn at the rail, angled outward nearing the end of the turn trying to get around the drifting Sir Marion Lewis, made contact with Hard To Find at the head of the lane, was herded inward by Jjalad the remainder of the drive and grudgingly ceded to that one nearing the wire. WHITE POST, well back toward mid track, bid off the rail approaching the final turn, improved steadily while taken outward through the lane but came back bleeding from the nose. HARD TO FIND rated off the pace about the three path, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole, held aim rounding the final turn but was pinched back in the upper stretch and offered no further response. SIR MARION LEWIS rated a short lead inside, came under pressure past the five sixteenths pole, drifted outward entering the stretch and dug in with the advantage to the sixteenth pole before weakening. MOLINARO DEPARTURE, well back saving ground, bid from the quarter pole and finished evenly near the rail. NEVER MOBIL, off the pace outside, made a mild bid while saving some ground on the final turn. FACSIMILE stalked

the pace two deep, gave chase from the half mile pole then faded approaching the final turn. STAMEN was hustled close to the early pace five wide then gave way after three eighths. After a stewards inquiry and subsequent claim of foul, Dangerous Warrior was disqualified from third and placed fifth for impeding Hard To Find in the upper stretch.
