ROMANTIC TWIST settled just off the leaders while saving ground along the rail, rallied determinedly through the stretch, got through and was along in time. LAKER CHEERLEADER also with the pace while racing three wide, rallied to gain a slight lead before the top of the stretch, brushed with HANG UP CALL, dug in when joined by the winner and finished second best. MISSTHEWIRE never far back, came between horses for the drive, angled four wide and finished with good courage. BEAUTY CHARM found her best stride late. TOTALLY PRECIOUS went evenly. HANG UP CALL prompted the pace around the first turn, went up to make the lead, dueled into the stretch while brushing with LAKER CHEERLEADER then weakened late. SAINTS AND SAGES was outrun. OUT OF POCKET set the early pace then faltered. BABY BIRD C C offered little.
