Footnotes

JOYFUL KISS set a clear, fast pace along the rail, repulsed a bid from DARTH TATER near the eighth pole, re-cleared nearing the sixteenth pole and lasted under energetic left-handed urging. CONFEDERATE SILVER was unhurried while saving ground early, advanced inside of foes around the far turn, tipped three wide turning for home, closed outside and just missed. DARTH TATER settled off the pace while racing two wide around the first turn, bid two wide around the far turn to loom boldly nearing the lane but flattened out in the drive. KING OF SCOTTLAND was unhurried in the two path early, advanced inside down the backstretch, continued an incremental gain three wide around the far turn, and came up empty while continuing on his left lead in the lane. ROBB'S WARRIOR failed to menace while racing three and four wide. GREELEY'S MISSILE raced along the rail around the first turn and had no response from the half-mile pole on. SPEEDY SAMMY stalked the winner two wide through the opening half-mile and faltered around the far turn.
