PROUD TRICK stalked the pace two wide around the first turn, took the lead near the seven-sixteenths pole, vied outside down the backstretch, drew clear and angled to the rail near the quarter pole, dug in inside of foes through the lane and prevailed. HONOUR THE VOW was unhurried while racing two wide early, rallied three wide around the far turn and slowly gained through the lane. MY JORDAN set the pace along the rail, vied inside of the winner down the backstretch, chased inside around the far turn, continued on his left lead through the lane, was in tight late and won the nod for the show. IN THE FAIRWAY raced two wide around the first turn, advanced two wide down the backstretch, continued to gain two deep around the far turn, continued on his left lead in the lane and finished evenly. BAKU saved ground early, raced three wide around the far turn and was never a factor. LORD GIN had brief speed three wide.
