Footnotes

ALLEN'S MONSTER pressured the pace two deep, moved to the front nearing the three sixteenths pole, dueled clear into the stretch and lasted under a steady drive. BIG RED RIVER settled back toward mid track, made a bid saving ground nearing the quarter pole, was under a drive from the top of the lane and finished well. YOU DO, reluctant to load, raced well back in mid track, saved some ground on the turn, angled five wide into the lane and finished a strong third. LORD PARKER chased the early pace off the rail, rounded the turn in the three path then leveled off late. CANE HILL TERRACE chased the pace inside, steadied at the rail nearing the head of the lane then angled out weakening. JOE'S LAD broke in making contact with Cape Tribulation, chased the leaders from the outside, rounded the turn four wide then weakened in the stretch. NO ATTRACTION chased the early pace two deep, rounded the turn in the three path then weakened in the lane. UNLIKELY HERO contested the early issue inside, yielded control toward the three sixteenths pole but continued a close factor to the head of the lane before weakening. CAPE TRIBULATION, bumped at the break, was taken in hand at the three eighths pole and collapsed a pole later. The stewards posted the inquiry before declaring this race official.
