GRANDANNA angled toward the inside to give early chase two deep, took the lead inside the five sixteenths pole, edged clear still under a hold approaching the head of the lane, was prompted at that point and held well under steady handling. FASHION CONSCIOUS chased the early pace two deep, eased to the three path midway on the turn and finished well to chase the winner home. MISTY'S REBELLION settled off the pace inside, came under a drive leaving the quarter pole and took over show midstretch before leveling off. LOVE LIKE OURS chased the pace toward mid track, saved some ground on the turn then leveled off in the lane. BID REPORT was hustled to a brief clear lead inside, gave chase past the five sixteenths pole then weakened in mid turn. GIGOLETTE and MIKESLITTEGIRL both raced well back and were not factors.
