SMILE SAMANTHA pressed the issue from the rail, made the lead on the turn, held clear through the stretch under a steady drive. MARIAS GOLDEN ROSE set the pace on a clear lead for a half, remained a factor around the turn but was second best. CULPEPER MOON forced the leaders along the inside, eased out four wide on the turn, lacked a closing bid. COSALINDA well placed just off the rail, lacked a late response. GREAT BRIDGE failed to menace along the inside. DARK CONTESSA a pace factor four wide, was easing around the turn, pulled up in the stretch then was vanned off after the finish.
