Footnotes

PINE BROOK rated a short lead inside, was pressured for run toward the quarter pole, drifted outward through the lane though held on well under a steady right hand drive. FOR APPEAL settled off the pace inside, bid off the rail into the final turn, came inside the drifting winner nearing the sixteenth pole but leveled off from that point. RAISING CHARLIE, unhurried outside, bid into the final turn and closed to late stretch before flattening stride. GERRYMANDER showed no speed inside and finished evenly on the rail. COACH DOUG stalked the pace off the rail and gave chase into the final turn before weakening. VALARS rated off the pace and off the rail and showed no response on the final turn. HOLY INTENTIONS was through after a half mile. SUBSCRIBER raced outside early and never factored. PROUD KING came away awkwardly and a step slow. CRAFTY CHIP lost contact early.
