VERONICA'S LAKE quickly drew clear to set the pace on the rail, lost some ground entering the stretch and continued to bear outward while proving to be much the best. SKY CAN FLY chased the pace in mid track, saved ground through the turn and just lasted in place. THE LAST DANCER broke outward, lacked room early while off the rail, eased out leaving the three sixteenths pole, entered the stretch five wide and finished well just missing place. WILD JAB chased the pace about the four path before leveling out in the lane. DANCINGINTHECITY lacked speed, improved her position widest on the turn and finished evenly. CRUSADER'S ANGEL saved ground. WILD RAINBOW came away sharply for a brief clear lead then gave chase two deep before fading on the turn. STARRING SKY came away a step slow. ADDINGBURG chased the pace through the backstretch and lost ground while giving way on the turn.
