BRIEF MARK pressed the pace just off the rail, gained a clear lead down the backstretch, drew off thereafter under a drive. HASTA LA PASTA stalked the leaders five wide, dropped down three wide on the turn, then was no match for the winner while easily second best. PRIZED AFFAIR five wide around the first turn, prompted the pace three wide, lacked a late response. TSUNAMI SUE within striking distance along the inside, came four wide on the turn, lacked a late bid. ALL THE GO off the pace four and five wide, lacked the needed rally. EXPLORING DORA forced the issue from the inside, failed to respond. BI ROSE passed tiring rivals, three wide. BILLY BROWN EYES made little impact, three wide. BROTHERLY LOVE set the pace on a slim lead, gave way around the turn. PRIVATELY APPROVED five wide into the first turn, steadied off heels then showed little thereafter.
