Footnotes

TOY STORE disputed the pace three wide between rivals down the backstretch, took a slim lead leaving the quarter pole, dueled outside of NUCKY THOMPSON in the three path to midstretch and edged ahead under a drive. NEVERDIDITTWICE disputed the early pace between rivals, was bumped by FIELD ARTILLERY near the three-eighths pole, angled inside nearing the turn, advanced in the two path around that bend, angled four wide nearing the lane and rallied between rivals to gain the place in deep stretch. NUCKY THOMPSON set the pace in the two path, dueled inside of the winner to midstretch and weakened while continuing on his left lead. RAVEN'S LUCK chased the pace six wide and finished willingly to just miss the show. HELL BENT lacked speed toward the inside and rallied mildly in the lane. FIELD ARTILLERY vied between rivals down the backstretch, bumped NEVERDIDITTWICE near the three-eighths pole, chased five wide around the turn and lacked a rally. ED EARL disputed the pace between rivals down the backstretch and faded while racing four wide around the turn. SARTORE broke awkwardly, raced three wide and never factored.
