TIME FOR ATONEMENT stalked the pace three wide around the first turn, advanced leaving the half-mile pole to vie outside of RUN FAT BOY RUN down the backstretch, drew clear while still in the three path near the three-sixteenths pole and held sway under a drive. HEY BATTER BATTER stalked the pace inside around the first turn, went three wide around the far turn and finished willingly. SUPREME RULER settled off the pace in the three path, advanced inside around the far turn and was along for the show. RUN FAT BOY RUN set the pace in the two path, vied inside of the winner from the half-mile pole to the three-sixteenths marker and weakened in the lane. PAGAN CAT saved ground early, had a mild four wide bid midway around the far turn then flattened out in the lane. WYATT'S HOPE failed to menace while racing four and five wide. TURF COUNT saved ground to no avail. MISTER FIPS (IRE) was outrun while racing three wide. IN PLACE chased the pace three wide and tired around the far turn.
