SIR FIT'S TOO MUCH settled off the pace in the three path, closed to the lead approaching the five sixteenths pole, came under a drive entering the stretch and held well with moderate though steady handling. ALLEGHENY JACK rated back inside, started his bid nearing the three eighths pole, came around the tiring pacesetter near the quarter and finished well to be second best. BRING ONTHE CHROME lunged at the start, settled well back outside, bid leaving the three eighths pole, came through the turn six wide and was along late for show. COUNTY ECHO, off the pace inside, bid angling outward on the final turn, entered the stretch four wide but had little left. WICKLIFFE MAN, close to the early pace, gave chase down the backstretch then leveled off through the lane. ACT TOO rated off the pace three wide then weakened saving ground on the final turn. LUCA'S WIND DANCER and ARCTIC CIRCLE were not factors. I'M A TERP became fractious unseating his rider behind the gate, moved clear early, was rated to the three eighths pole, pressured beyond that point then faded on the final turn.
