Footnotes

BELIEVEINTHEPRIZE set the pace along the rail, drew off around the far turn and continued to widen under a drive in the lane. KITTENISH tracked the pace two wide, could not keep pace with the winner around the far turn while moving into second and just lasted for the place. ALLEN'S LAST DANCE settled off the pace while racing four wide, never threatened the winner but was gaining on the runner-up late. SHARP BOURBON was bumped just after the start, lacked speed inside, raced three wide around the far turn and lacked a serious rally. KRISTINA STELLA was reluctant to load, prompted the pace two wide and faltered around the far turn. MISS SILVER BULETT was bumped just after the start and never factored while racing two wide. SULTRYEYESFORU was outrun while racing three and four wide. LIVELY BELLE was outrun while racing four and five wide.
