**Footnotes**

AL N CON chased the pace four wide after a brief early lead, contested a slight disadvantage rounding the turn but dug in from the head of the lane to get up inside the sixteenth pole and was inching away under the wire. SILVER SPIKE stalked the early pace inside, was shuffled back past the five sixteenths pole, bid from mid turn, dueled to a slim brief lead in the upper stretch but reluctantly ceded the final yards. U BOAT ALLEY rated close outside, settled evenly five wide rounding the turn, came under a drive entering the stretch and finished well. IGON gave distant chase inside, eased outward a couple of lanes through the stretch and finished well. HEAR MY VOICE set a pressured pace two deep, dug in to maintain the edge through the turn, yielded to the runner-up in the upper stretch then leveled off nearing the wire. JOHNNY JOE hesitated a full length at the break, raced well back to the quarter pole, improved from there and finished well inside. WATCH TOWER chased the pace off the rail, eased outward from the middle of the turn but leveled off in the stretch. TETON PASS chased the pace outside, rounded the turn six wide and came up empty in the stretch. LEON ROYALE gave chase from well back and outside then came seven wide on the turn. D C'S PRIDE pressed the pace three wide to the quarter pole before fading.
