MISS FIRETHORN bid four wide on the turn, closed strongly to be clear late. WRONG GIRL rallied three wide on the turn, had aim in the upper stretch but hung. CUTTY SHARK well placed, lacked a late response. WILD GOOSE CHASE came six wide around the turn then closed well. FLYING RAIL set the pace, weakened in the drive. CRAFTY ACQUITTAL wore a nasal strip, came five wide on the turn finding her best stride late. CHRIS'S COLLEEN wore a nasal strip, was well placed, failed to respond. ME FOXY failed to menace. ADAM LETS SHARE hard used, tired. DAN CIN QUICK forced the pace for a half then stopped.
