**Footnotes**

RED GHOST exchanged repeated contact with Lil Marvin the opening strides, settled unhurriedly inside, started his drive while eased outward on the final turn and continued in a steady advance to get the lead the final strides. FORT APACHE STAR, unhurried off the rail, bid angling outward on the final turn, closed through traffic for a short brief lead in deep stretch but was outfinished the closing strides. DISCO INDY raced with the early pace two deep, contested a slim advantage on the final turn and remained the main factor to deep stretch before weakening. SIR DIAMOND, off the pace off the rail, started his drive into the final turn, eased three wide into the stretch and continued to drift outward while weakening. RUN WARRIOR RUN showed no speed to the head of the lane and finished well. LORD OF DANCE rated a short lead inside on the backstretch, was pressured on the rail approaching the final turn and dueled close to the sixteenth pole before giving way. COVERT ACTION, off the pace and off the rail, bid into the final turn then carried outward into the lane and weakened from there. SHOULD EXPECT stumbled at the break, had range the opening half mile then faded. LIL MARVIN exchanged early contact with Red Ghost and was outrun. BAY BUTTON BILL was not a factor.
