Footnotes

LAW'S HILL pressured the early pace four wide, contested at even terms while three wide on the turn, dug in for the lead nearing the sixteenth pole and edged clear toward the wire. BLANCHE'S NARDER chased the pace two deep, saved ground inside the three eighths pole, dueled with a slim advantage at the rail past the three sixteenths pole, yielded to the winner in midstretch but held on well for place. BONDED MESSENGER stalked the early pace inside, was shuffled back at the heels of Blanche's Narder toward the three eighths pole, recovered stride four wide on the turn and finished well to show. WITNESS PROTECTION, slow into stride, chased the pace about the three path, steadied at the heels of Slamentine in late stretch though finished well while making his way in tight traffic. SLAMENTINE set a pressured pace three wide down the backstretch, dueled with a slim lead while between horses on the turn then weakened wavering lanes inside the sixteenth pole. SAINT ANTHONY showed no speed well back inside then bid mildly off the rail through the stretch. KIDS GOT SKILLS chased the pace toward mid track then lost ground weakening into the stretch. WELCOME CITI was not a factor. STAR OVER DUBAI chased the pace off the rail then weakened while losing ground through the turn. PROSPECT CAT raced wide and was never a factor.
