Footnotes

CASEY ON THE RUN settled back about the three path, bid leaving the three eighths pole, was carried five wide past the three sixteenths pole but dug in from there to take over midstretch and edged clear toward the wire. HOOCH'S BLUFF, brushed early, settled back inside, made a bid nearing the three eighths pole, angled out from the middle of the final turn, was at nearly even terms in midstretch but outfinished to the wire. X F BUCKLES stalked the pace off the rail, took aim leaving the three eighths pole, dueled to the front midway on the final turn, was caught a sixteenth away and leveled off from there. SAGE BLOSSOM, brushed early, rated close to the pace off the rail, gave chase three wide from the half mile pole, was carried outward into the lane and weakened. STELLA M rated a slow pace inside, came under a drive from the three eighths pole and held the advantage to the middle of the final turn before weakening. MILLIE'S ANGEL stalked the pace about the three path for three eighths of a mile before fading. ZARAGIANA jostled between rivals early and never factored.
