**Footnotes**

KNOCKOUT PUNCH within striking distance four and five wide, rallied around the turn and in a strong drive was up in the final strides. FRAN THE GREAT forced the issue three wide, drew on even terms with the winner in late stretch and just missed. SCOTCH TWIST pressed the pace three wide, dropped to the rail on the turn, had aim in the stretch, dug in but was out finished. GREEN SPRING BOY well placed along the rail, finished with good energy through the stretch. MR. DEL SUR bore out at the start, prompted the issue three and four wide, lacked a closing bid. BLANCHE'S NARDER set the pace on a clear lead into the stretch, weakened the last sixteenth.
