**Footnotes**

KISSIN IN THE DARK broke in to make contact with Vero Beach, set a clear pace well off the rail, saved ground through the turn then dug in under a steady stretch drive to hold on. BETTY PORTLOCK broke out making contact with Vero Beach, chased the pace off the rail, dug in through the lane and was gaining slowly approaching the wire. REALLY BULLISH exchanged light contact with Intimate storm early on, picked up the chase toward mid track, angled to the rail leaving the five sixteenths pole, gained mildly to midstretch but leveled off toward the wire. CASHED OUT chased the pace from the three and four paths then leveled out down the lane. RACING WILDLY gave chase off the rail and had little left through the lane. V T JULES chased the pace outside, saved some ground through the turn, swung eight wide entering the stretch and passed tiring rivals. INTIMATE STORM exchanged light contact with Really Bullish early, chased the pace toward mid track, saved some ground into the turn, swung seven wide entering the stretch and showed little further. KENTUCKY MELODY chased the pace toward the outside, left the turn six wide and weakened down the lane. VERO BEACH came away a step slow and was bumped from both sides upon exit, chased the leaders in the three and four paths, eased outward through the turn, entered the stretch nine wide and weakened. MIRA LA LUNA chased the pace toward mid track then faded five wide rounding the turn.
