Footnotes

OPERATIVE settled off the pace toward mid track, rallied to the lead inside the quarter pole, was quickly clear from there and widened under moderate handling. SWEET HALUCINATION rated off the pace off the rail, started a four wide drive from the quarter pole and finished evenly in place. THE FENIAN WARRIOR rated a short lead off the rail, edged clear past the three eighths pole, though flattened stride on the final turn. DREAMED showed no speed well back and inside, angled outward making his bid into the final turn but had nothing further in the stretch. THEPOWERSINYOU was outrun. BRAYZEN BILLY settled close to the pace inside, took aim approaching the final turn then weakened in the stretch. EXTREME HOPE, off the pace outside, weakened on the final turn. SECOND TO NONE stalked the early pace inside, dropped back leaving the five sixteenths pole then gave way on the final turn.
