SANTORINI SUN was unruly behind the starting gate, set the pace along the rail and drew off under a drive. SIGNATURE RUN was unhurried along the inside, advanced up the rail around the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and rallied for the place. ROCKY MARSH raced off the pace while three wide throughout and was just up for the show. R PAINTED PAYNE stalked the pace inside, was no match for the winner around the far turn and was outfinished for the minor awards. BROOKS IN TOWN raced along the rail and failed to menace. DAINICHI chased the pace two wide and tired around the far turn. WESTERN SELECT walked out of the gate and bore in, saved some ground and passed tiring rivals. FIRST MINISTER raced four wide and lugged in in the stretch. THE BUTLER DID IT chase the pace three and four wide and tired after a half.
