REVERE, four wide the opening turn, settled close leaving the turn, took over approaching the five sixteenths pole, urged clear into the final turn, was driven from the three sixteenths pole and dug in under hardy stretch encouragement to hold on. DAPPER DUDE settled off the pace inside, started a bid at the three eighths pole, improved off the rail rounding the final turn, was driven into the lane, gaining steadily approaching the wire and just missed. TWO TO LOAD settled well back off the rail, bid toward the quarter pole, settled evenly near the rail rounding the turn, was driven through the lane and dueled for show. CANAL STREET rated close inside, steadied past the five sixteenths pole, gave chase from the quarter pole, eased out into the lane but leveled off. JUST BECAUSE rated a slim lead from the nine sixteenths pole, was caught nearing the five sixteenths, continued close pursuit near the rail rounding the final turn but weakened in the stretch. FAN DEMON saved ground early, eased toward the outside leaving the opening turn and passed tiring rivals. CHUCK TOWN CHARLIE was not a factor racing off the rail. ST. JOHNSWOOD saved ground the opening turn, eased out with a mild bid at the half mile pole then faded in the three path of the final turn. VIDEO STORM, just off the early pace about the three path, gave chase leaving the three eighths pole then leveled off in the four path of the final turn. DILLONBEGON engaged in close chase three wide past the five eighths pole but faded after a half mile.
