PEACE BUSTER was hustled along inside to chase the pace, eased just outside the pacesetter leaving the turn and dug in from the head of the lane to get up the final strides. CRAZY AS CAN BE moved clear while angling inward, set the pace to the top of the stretch, dug in to the challenge of the winner though reluctantly ceded to that one the final strides. DESTINED TO DANCE, well back inside, started a drive at the rail leaving the quarter pole, finished well and was gaining on the top two. SOLVE THE CODE chased the pace inside to midstretch before leveling off. MR. DUNKIN chased the early pace three wide, drifted out making contact with Hodiescodie past the five sixteenths pole, lost more ground through the turn, entered the stretch in the six path and leveled off. I'M A LUMBERJACK chased the early pace outside and finished evenly while improving his position in the stretch. BON APPETIT chased the early pace two deep, lost ground on the turn then weakened in the stretch. MARIAS PASS, shuffled back at the start, was no factor in distant chase outside. HODIESCODIE chased the early pace about the four path, was brushed outward getting his heels clipped by Garnered Ice past the five sixteenths pole, carried further outward through the turn then leveled off in the stretch. GARNERED ICE chased the pace toward the outside, was shut off clipping the heels of Hodiescodie past the five sixteenths pole and lost his rider as a result. The stewards posted the inquiry and disqualified Mr. Dunkin from fifth to last place, for causing a chain reaction which resulted in the loss of rider on Garnered Ice
