Footnotes

WILD PROOF accelerated to the front while angling inward, rated the pace to the middle of the final turn, came under pressure at that point and dug in under a hardy drive to widen. BLUE SOLDIER rated off the pace and off the rail, bid leaving the three eighths pole, had close aim rounding the final turn but leveled off in the drive. THUNDER OF LOVE, unhurried inside, bid toward the five sixteenths pole and finished well near the rail. IF AND ALMOST, off the pace inside, gave chase from the five sixteenths pole then leveled off through the lane. OUT TO PLEASE rated close to the winner inside, lost ground through the final turn and weakened in the stretch. SHOP SMART rated off the pace about the three path, gave chase from the three eighths pole but had little further on the final turn. FOOLISH BID, well back off the rail, made a mild bid leaving the half mile pole. CAN'T WATCH, unhurried about the three path early, had no response near the rail on the final turn. BLIND BLUFF was not a factor. CALVIN B raced well back toward mid track.
