Footnotes

MY NAME IS RALPHIE stalked the early pace from the inside, came under pressure leaving the three eighths pole, eased off the rail entering the stretch and closed steadily from there to get up the final strides. STAR KICKER quickly established control to rate the pace inside, came under pressure leaving the three sixteenths pole, was steadily driven through the lane but caught in the final strides. TOSSABOUQUET rated close to the early pace inside, dropped back from the five sixteenths pole, eased slightly outward while recovering stride on the final turn, finished well for show and was gaining on the top two. C B ROCKS settled back inside, eased outward into the backstretch, made a mild bid in the four path from the half mile pole, rounded the final turn five wide then leveled off in the stretch. REMEMBERYOURPLACE rated just off the pace about the three path, bid nearing the three eighths pole then faded on the final turn. RIVER LIME, four wide the second turn, bid from the half pole, had aim toward the final turn but leveled off in the stretch.
