Footnotes

NORTHWEST EXPRESS moved to the front while angling to the inside to rate a clear pace, came under pressure from the five sixteenths pole and dug in under hardy encouragement through the lane. SCENIC BEAUTY stalked the pace off the rail, made a bid from the five sixteenths pole and finished evenly to be second best. HARRIET'S CHARIOT, well back toward mid track early, came under a drive off the rail from the quarter pole and finished evenly in show. IMPENDING DANGER stalked the early pace about the three path, picked up the chase from the three eighths pole, took the rail on the final turn then weakened in the stretch. CAROLINA SQUALL raced well back off the rail. MALIBU FEVER was not a factor. MISS GINA H settled back toward the rail and never factored.
